TO GET STARTED, YOU WILL NEED:

A4 white paper

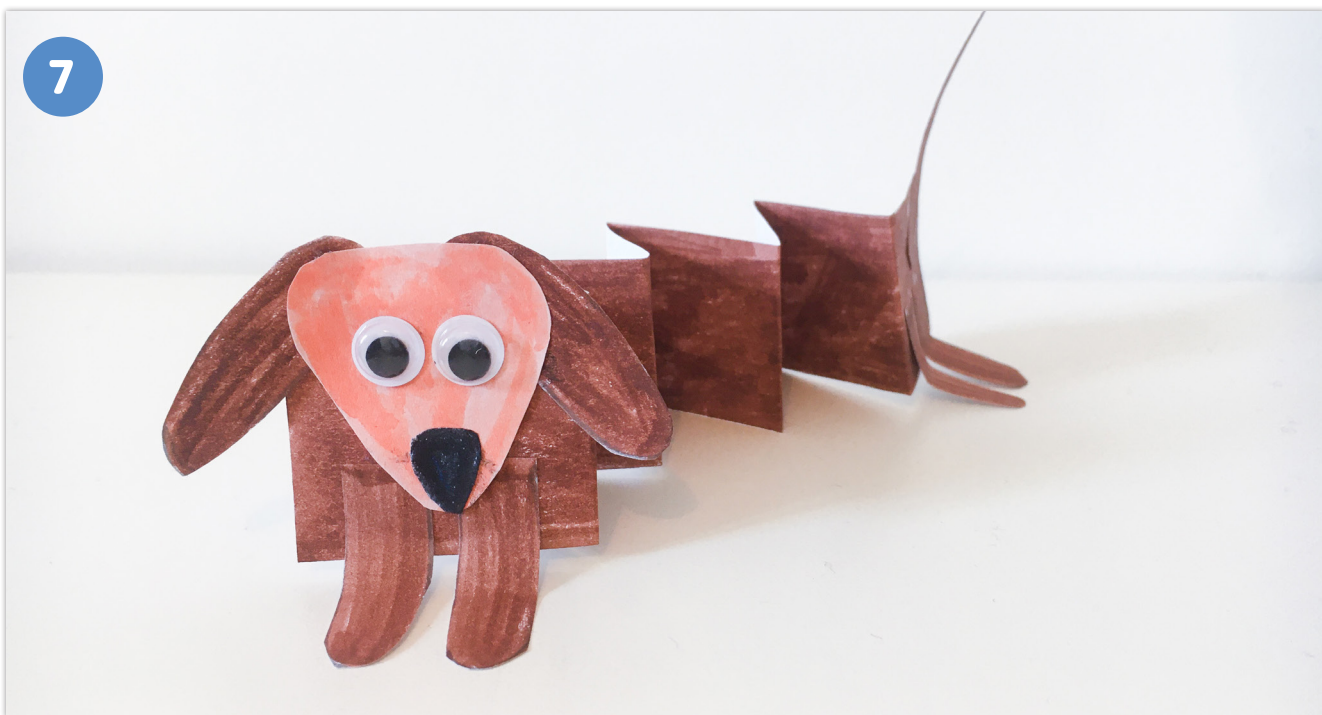
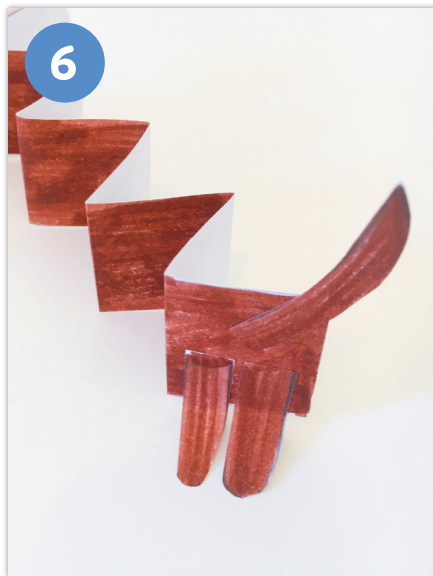
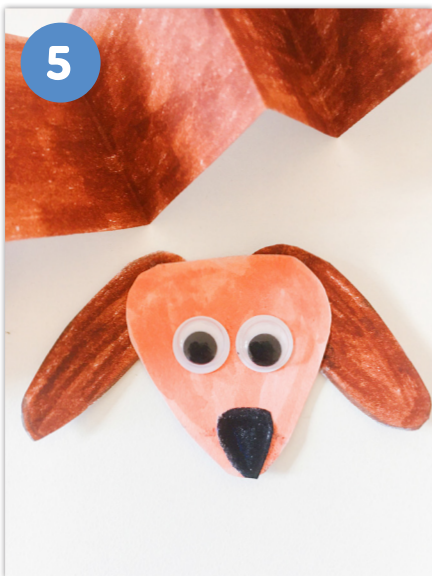
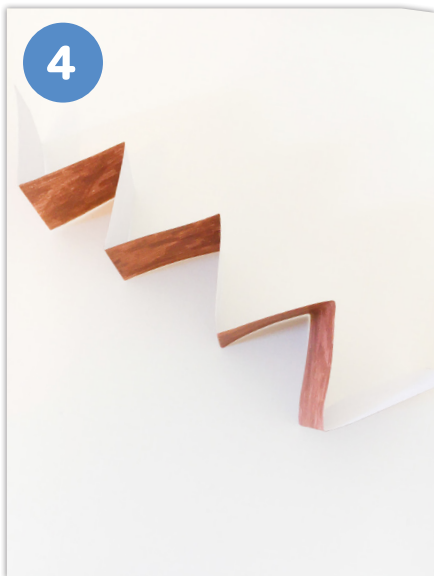
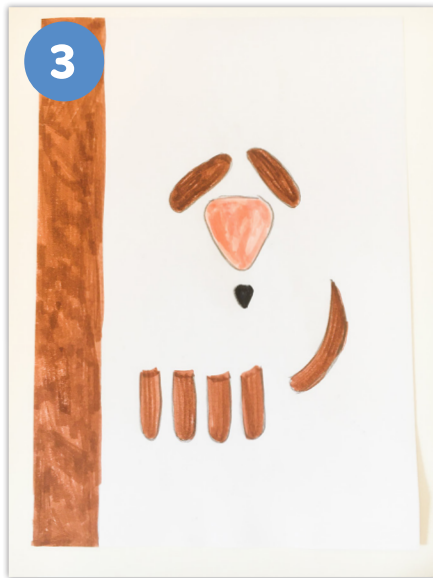
A pen and coloured pencils

Scissors

Glue

Googly eyes (optional)

INSTRUCTIONS:



- 1.** On your paper, draw a straight line from the top to the bottom of your page, about 5cm from the side. This strip of paper will be used for the sausage dog's body.
- 2.** Use the remaining space on the paper to draw shapes for the sausage dog's ears, head, nose, tail, and four legs.
- 3.** Colour in the dog's body parts and ask an adult to help you cut them out.
- 4.** Fold the long strip of paper about 2cm forward and then backward until you have folded the entire sausage dog body.
- 5.** To assemble the dog's head, glue the ears to the back of the head and add the nose and the eyes. If you don't have googly eyes, you can draw eyes with a black pen.
- 6.** Glue two legs and the tail on the back of the dog.
- 7.** Glue two legs and the head on the front and... your sausage dog is ready to solve some mysteries!
