TO GET STARTED, YOU WILL NEED:

Two cardboard toilet paper rolls

Coloured paper or paint

A piece of string

Glue

Scissors









INSTRUCTIONS:

- **1.** You will need: two cardboard toilet paper rolls, coloured paper or paint, a piece of string, glue and scissors.
- **2.** Cut out strings of coloured paper and glue them on to the cardboard rolls to decorate as you like. You can also use paint to decorate the rolls if you prefer.
- **4.** Glue the two rolls together and add extra strings of paper or decoration to the binoculars.
- **5.** Using glue or tape, attach the string to your binoculars. You are ready to explore!
- **6.** Your elephant is ready. Make more to create your own herd of elephants.
