TO GET STARTED, YOU WILL NEED:


An empty jar

Card or paper

A piece of string

Colouring pens and pencils

Scissors













INSTRUCTIONS:

- **1.** On a white piece of card of paper, draw a rectangular shape (about 5cmx6cm).
- 2. Decorate the inside of the rectangle as you wish to create a label for your jar.
- **3-4.** Cut out the label and ask a grown up to help you attach it to the jar with string.
- **5-6.** Write down your wishes, fold them up and collect them in your wishing jar, ready for any fairies that might pass by... (<u>learn all about wish granting fairies in The Old Lady Who Lived in a Vinegar Bottle.</u>)
